- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 6 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the respective Faculty at TU Liberec before the departure of the student. The student receives a booklet, "Index", where he/she is supposed to collect signatures from the teachers to confirm passed courses and examinations. This system is parallel to the on-line system and ensures a fast processing of the transcript of records that the student should pick up at the student Office of the faculty before leaving TU Liberec.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The present bilateral agreement will be valid during the academic years 2014/15 - 2020/21, unless either side terminates the agreement in writing at the latest by September 30^{th} for activities taking placing during the next (n+1) academic year. Additional activities, cancellations or new subject areas are to be communicated by the same deadline.

Vilnius University:

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks after the deadline.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
