- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 (five) weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unllateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

Vilnius University:

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks after the deadline.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September

20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
